- Felipe reported landscaping renovations continue throughout the Park. A

- Katie Davis distributed the Palomar West Capital Projects Listing for Fiscal 2021/2022. Katie indicated a white vinyl Bocce Ball fence was approved to provide privacy and reduce noise for residents whose homes back up to the court. Funds for these projects will be available July 1st. The Board will consider purchasing benches for the area.
